## **A Message From Mr. Willey**

All Oregon students in grades 3-12 participate in the Smarter Balanced English Language Arts & Math tests. These tests identify your child's strengths and areas for improvement. Each subject is broken into categories and show how well your child performs in each area. The tests measure student learning on a continuous scale. The state has set four achievement levels along this scale that generally describe where students are. The results will be available at the start of the next school year. Our teachers find this information very valuable, and I encourage every student to take these tests. House Bill 2655 allows parents to opt-out their child from taking one or both tests. To do so you will have to complete the 2017-18 Opt-Out Form, which is available on our school website under the "Parents" tab or through our main office.
